Course Overview

Postgraduate students spend 9 months on PIHMS campus studying a combination of business studies and operational subjects. The learning environment is set in the context of an operational hotel. Participating in a combination of theoretical and business subjects. Applying this knowledge to running the PIHMS hotel is excellent preparation for the next step into work based learning.

Entry Requirements

Applicants require an appropriate Bachelor Degree (Hotel, Business, Management). Qualifications in other disciplines may be considered on a case by case basis with relevant work experience.

Applicants for whom English is not their first language, IELTS 6.5 (no band below 6) or equivalent is required.

POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMME

1 YEAR - 120 credits

Business subjects:

- Applied Evaluation Research for Hotels
- Applied Operations Management in Hotels
- Finance for Hotel Managers
- Leadership and Human Resources Management in Hotels
- Strategic Hotel Management
- Strategic Marketing Management for Hotels

Applied Operations Management will be conducted while learners are working in Hotels, this component requires a minimum of 150 hours of learning to occur over a minimum of 10 weeks

Course Overview

Masters students will spend 9 months on PIHMS hotel campus participating in business studies courses, focusing on the application of these courses within the PIHMS hotel context. Connection to the Hotel industry is by way of work base learning, beginning with Applied Operations Management, followed by two research based courses - Quantitative Research in Hotel Management and Qualitative Research in Hotel Management.

The excellent mix of theoretical and operational courses coupled with added research skills, ensure PIHMS masters students are extremely valuable at a high level to employers.

As an alternative research pathway, high performing learners may be invited to the Work-based Applied Research Project in Hotel Management.

Entry Requirements

Applicants require an appropriate Bachelor Degree (Hotel, Business, Management etc) with a B- or equivalent GPA; appropriate work experience is preferable.

Applicants for whom English is not their first language, IELTS 6.5 (no band below 6) or equivalent is required.


